DETAIL DESIGN - AIM TO IMPLEMENT IN 2023

- × Cowper Street Green School Zone (NTA part funded, Phase 1 implementation in 2023)
- × Moira Road Pocket Park, between Ben Edair Road & Niall Street
- × Tree planting on Fitzwilliam Place, Ben Edair Road & Ivar Street
- × Montpelier Hill Tree planting & SuDS scheme. Parks with the Water Framework Directive
- × Blackhorse Lane tree planting

FEASIBILITY, DESIGN & CONSULTATION IN 2023

- × Park improvements at Aughrim Street MUGA - Feasibility study
- × Tree planting on Oxmantown Road, Halliday Road, Ross street, Manor Place, Kirwan Street (entrance trees), Finn Street & Joseph’s Road

Our process involves detailed consultation with local residents groups & residents.

We will continue working with the local community to implement the projects identified in the Stoneybatter Greening Strategy.

- × Diamond Park - on site - Park opening at the end of May
- × Cross Care Community Centre - on site - complete Q2
- × James Joyce Street park - on site - Complete Q2
- × Green Walls on Commons Street and Courtney Place - complete Q2

DETAIL DESIGN - AIM TO IMPLEMENT IN 2023

- × Customs House Quay - de-paving of approximately 600 sqm of hard standing & replacing with tree, shrub herbaceous and bulb planting.
- × The North East Inner City Greening Strategy URBAN TREE TRAIL - Project to map and design a trail around the NEIC. (First Urban Tree trail in Ireland).

FEASIBILITY, DESIGN & CONSULTATION IN 2023

- × Mountjoy Square Park Refurbishment - Part 8 process
- × East Wall Recreational Centre – Park Refurbishment - Consultant tender issued
- × Railway Street - Inter departmental consultation stage
- × Community projects -working with Ballybough Pride of Place group and other local groups to implement green infrastructure projects
- × DCC Housing - building on success of Liberty House & Ballybough House, it is proposed to implement a number of greening projects in collaboration with DCC housing
- × Street Tree Greening interventions in collaboration with residents on: Summer Street North, Russell’s Street, Portland Street North, Portland Place, Campbell’s Row & Lane & Belvedere Avenue, Sherrard Street Lower and Sherrard Avenue

- × Buckingham Street - Progress Feasibility Study
- × Store Street & Plaza - Consultation & Design
- × Adopt a tree Project - Ongoing
- × Summer Street Greening Feasibility Study
- × Urban Forestry - Work with land managers to develop temporary urban forestry in derelict sites.
